

PERSONAL RESILIENCE – PREPARATION CHECKLISTS AND HOUSEHOLD PLANS

HOUSEHOLD EMERGENCY SUPPLY CHECKLIST

Resource	Recommendation	
Water	Water for three days or more - make sure you have at least nine litres of water for every person.	
Food	At least three days of food that doesn't need cooking (unless you have a camping stove or BBQ), food/formula for babies and pet food. Consider whether you need to pack a can opener, knife or scissors.	
Torch and battery-powered lighting	 Torch and batteries. Battery powered lighting is the safest and easiest. Do not use candles as they can tip over in a gust of wind or in earthquake aftershocks and start a fire. Do not use kerosene lamps, they need a lot of ventilation and are not designed for indoor use. Batteries need to be checked and replaced regularity 	ularly.
Radio	A solar- or battery-powered radio, so you can keep up with the latest news and alerts. In an emergency you can also use your car radio.	
Bucket with lid and toilet paper	As a makeshift toilet.	
Protective Clothing	Dust masks and work gloves, to protect yourself. Windproof and waterproof clothing.	
Fire extinguisher	A small fire extinguisher. For advice on fire extinguishers and how to use them, visit: www.fireandemergency.nz/at-home/fire-extinguisher.	ishers
Blankets	Blankets or sleeping bags.	
Pet supplies	For information about preparing and planning for your animals (livestock, lifestyle block,	



	horse and pets) in an emergency, visit: www.mpi.govt.nz/animals-in-emergencies	
Medical equipment	 First aid kit Essential medications Medical equipment such as hearing aids, oxygen, glasses or mobility aids. 	
OPTIONAL	Solar powered phone charger	

Check and replace food and water every twelve months. Consider stocking a two-week supply of food and water for prolonged emergencies such as a pandemic.
